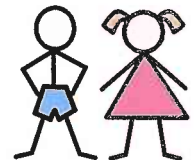


Most children identified 'making things' , going on visits [visitors]

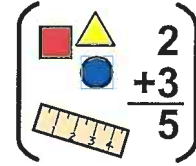
Children identified thinking, learning, a growth mindset, and



'growing my neurons'. Others were able to identify new skills.



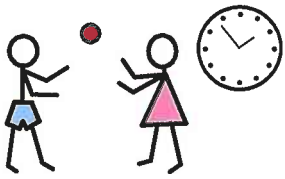
